Hopkins Demonstration Forest is a non-profit

outdoor educational facility, founded in 1990 by Forests Forever, Inc. to provide learning opportunities for woodland owners and students and visitors of all ages to learn. Here we provide educators and programs to teach sustainable forestry management, fire prevention and defensible space measures, stream and wetlands protection, and fish and wildlife enhancement. Five miles of trails provide outdoor recreational opportunities throughout the forest with interpretive signing. The historic Molalla Log House and Clatskanie Fire Lookout Tower provide visitors an opportunity to learn about our cultural heritage related to the forest.

Everett Hall is a lodge-like meeting hall in the forest, with an outdoor patio with expansive views of the forest. It has kitchen facilities and audio-visual technology for community meetings and special events. We also operate our own sawmill to mill lumber for building projects such as the educational Outreach Center, picnic shelters, outdoor amphitheater and educational kiosks.



Hopkins is open dawn until dusk every day of the year, at no cost to the public.
